### **Signature Identity Tip** – Shared by Ocean County Board of Election Staff Instructor:

Our signature starts out GOOD going to bad. If a signature starts out bad and comes good this is fraudulent.



In another words if signature on ID is so-so and the actual signature is good, this needs to be questioned for fraud.

**Reminder:** take precautions while at an appointment on how you proceed in a suspicious situation.
